At Rotoiti Lodge Outdoor Education Centre, safety is our top priority. We are committed to ensuring that all risks are properly assessed and managed, while still offering enriching and enjoyable outdoor learning experiences. We acknowledge that some activities inherently involve a certain level of risk, but our goal is to minimise and control these risks to the highest degree possible, always prioritising the well-being of our participants.

Qualworx Certified

Rotoiti Lodge Outdoor Education Centre (RLOEC) is a fully registered Adventure Activity Operator with Worksafe NZ and is subject to rigorous, external audits by a national safety auditing body, in line with the Adventure Activities Regulations 2011. We undergo an audit each year to ensure ongoing compliance with safety standards.

Safety Management Systems

Each activity at Rotoiti Lodge has its own detailed set of Safety Operating Procedures, which are carefully documented in our Operations Manuals and stored in the Lodge offices. These procedures are regularly reviewed and updated to reflect best practices and ensure the highest level of safety for all participants.

Activities and Equipment

All equipment used at Rotoiti Lodge is thoroughly checked and maintained by trained staff to ensure it is safe, functional, and appropriate for use throughout the year. We take every measure to guarantee that our equipment meets the highest standards of safety for all participants and staff.

Staff

Our staff members are carefully selected for their expertise and experience in outdoor education. They hold recognised qualifications and certifications that demonstrate their competence in leading outdoor activities. All staff members are current in First Aid and undergo a minimum of three weeks of intensive training, followed by ongoing assessments to ensure their skills remain. They follow a structured training pathway before they are authorised to lead activities, ensuring that safety is never compromised.

Safety Goals

At the end of each year, our team sets new safety goals for the upcoming year, focusing on areas where we can improve or risks we aim to avoid. These goals are discussed and reviewed in weekly health and safety meetings, and a more comprehensive review is conducted at the end of each term to ensure we are continually evolving our safety practices and maintaining the highest standards of care.
